



EXPLORE THE LURE OF THE DEEP

PADI DEEP DIVER COURSE \$549

The lure of the deep. There's something exciting and mysterious about exploring deeper dive sites while scuba diving. Sometimes it's a wreck that attracts you below 18 metres/60 feet, and on wall dives it may be a giant fan or sponge. Whatever it is, to scuba dive with confidence at depths down to 40 metres/130 feet, you should take the PADI Deep Diver Specialty course.

If you've earned the PADI Adventure Diver rating or higher, and you're at least 15 years old, you can enroll in the Deep Diver course.

EQUIPMENT

We are able to hire basic SCUBA Gear upon request (Wetsuit, Hood, Boots, Fins, BCD, Regs, Tanks, Weights) however, at this stage it is recommended you have all your own personal gear.

You are also required to bring the following:

- DSMB & Reel
- Dive Computer
- Compass

All course participants benefit from 10% off RRP any items instore prior to the course

Cylinders are provided as part of the course and will need to be picked up from Tasmanian Divers prior to the weekend

DIVE MEDICALS DO I NEED ONE?

You are required to complete a confidential medical questionnaire.

This questionnaire is sent out with your eLearning and is accessed via your digital forms online. If you have any issues accessing your digital forms, please let us know.

You must complete these forms prior to the pool session.

Any positive responses to the questions will require you to obtain a dive medical.

If you are aged over 40 a dive medical is required regardless.

If you require a dive medical, please contact us for further paperwork and information.

While you may not require a dive medical, there is always the potential for an examination to pick up medical issues you were previously unaware of. Due to this, we ask you to sign a medical waiver to acknowledge this risk.

We conduct our PADI Deep speciality out of Eaglehawk Dive Centre

Students will need to meet at the dive centre at 8 am on Saturday with all their SCUBA equipment (including two tanks).

- The Sisters (35m)

Sunday:

- The Nord (40m)
- Cathedral Caves (21m)
